Last weekend across the country Catholic churches counted how many people attended Mass. Our figures were up by 155 to 625, which means that our English speaking Masses have remained stable over the past 6 months. The rise is due to the 155 attending the our Syro-Malabar Catholic Liturgy at 2pm at St Anthony's. You can see clearly how that community are greatly increasing the health and viability of our parish by their presence. When added to many other parishioners across both churches, it means that around one third of our practising parishioners are first or second-generation Scots: thank God for the gift they are to us!
